<b>Travelling/ Housing</b>	<p>As Erasmus Office, unfortunately we cannot provide any accommodation for students. But they can utilize private dormitories or apartments that are within walking distance from the campus. The rents range from 2000 TL to 4000 TL depending on the apartments and the rooms are always furnished.</p> <p>Although, we cannot guarantee a place for them, we have a self-motivated student community which helps the students. Please keep in mind that, they will receive an e-mail from Erasmus Office about buddies before their arrival to Sakarya. Or your students may contact our community from Instagram page: <b>ESN Sakarya</b></p> <p>Also, buddy students help Erasmus students with their travel arrangements and inform them about the university, city and the country during their whole stay.</p>

<b>Health Services</b>	<p>We have our own hospital (Mediko) in the campus in which all incoming Erasmus students can benefit all health services by paying money. In addition, they may benefit from the all public and private hospitals located in the city center, but before coming they must have health &amp; travel insurance.</p>
<b>Other Estimated Costs</b>	<p><b>Food (monthly):</b> Depending on their way of life, food cost changes approximately between 75-150 Euros per month. (eating out or cooking at home)</p> <p><b>Transportation (monthly):</b> Although it depends on location where they live, urban transport costs not more than 30 Euros. Moreover,</p>

	students can have cards (called Card 54) on which they load money. By using these cards on buses, they can benefit some privileges such as receiving discount for transportation.

Course Information	
<b>Selecting Courses</b>	<p>At Sakarya University, we provide instruction on three degree programs (First/Bachelor, Second/Master, and Third/Doctorate Cycle). There is not any restriction for Erasmus students about selecting courses. They can choose courses from any faculty as long as the courses are not available or overlapping.</p> <p>Although language of instruction is Turkish at our university, every academic year, we arrange a list of courses taught in English and inform Erasmus students about this list.</p> <p>Moreover, we have <b>free elective courses</b> for all Sakarya University students as well as Erasmus students. This list consists of not only professional courses, but also social ones such as swimming, photography, gymnastics, badminton, boxing, basketball, and so on. If they want to learn Turkish during their stay, they may also choose Turkish Language Course (TDE 285 for Fall Semester and TDE 286 for Spring Semester).</p>
<b>ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)</b>	The credit accumulation system used at Sakarya University is ECTS. At our university, students accumulate 30 ECTS credits per semester.
