Health Insurance	Proof of health insurance is needed to get enrolled at TU Darmstadt. There are three possibilities:  1. European Health Insurance Card. This card must be valid until the end of the exchange stay at TU Darmstadt or  2. Confirmation of existing health insurance written in English. This confirmation has to be proved by a German compulsory health insurance or  3. Purchase of a German Health Insurance. Costs are approximately 85 EUR per month, contract period per semester.  The European Health Insurance Card often only covers the costs in case of emergencies and urgent illness. Students have to be informed about the services and treatments that are covered by their health insurance before they come to Darmstadt! Treatments for chronic diseases will be billed. In these cases, it will be necessary to arrange an additional travel health insurance in the student's home country.  https://tinyurl.com/tuda-health-insurance
